



## Casitas MWD Agricultural Rebate Program Terms and Conditions

The goal of the Agricultural Rebate Program is to encourage greater water use efficiency for farms within the Casitas Municipal Water District boundaries. District customers who enlist an irrigation evaluation through the Ventura County Resource Conservation District (VCRCD) and who implement water use efficiency recommendations provided by the VCRCD will be eligible to qualify for a rebate from Casitas MWD according to the terms and conditions listed here.

**REBATE AMOUNT: Total rebate amount will not exceed 50% of the receipt amount or a maximum amount of \$400.**

Please review Eligibility Requirements and Application Instructions to find out how to qualify for the rebate before proceeding further.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Check your water bill to verify that you're a customer of one of the following participating water agencies: Casitas Municipal Water District; City of Ventura (located in Casitas District boundaries); Ventura River County Water District; Golden State Water Company; Sisar Mutual Water Company; Siete Robles Mutual Water Company; Senior Canyon Mutual Water Company; Rincon Water & Roads Works; Old Creek Road Water Association; Hermitage Mutual Water Company; Meiners Oaks County Water District; Sulphur Mountain Road Water Association; and Tico Mutual Water Company.
- Contact the VCRCD to schedule an irrigation evaluation.
- After completing an irrigation evaluation through the VCRCD, applicants will receive an evaluation report with recommendations to improve irrigation efficiency. Equipment recommendations specified within this report will be eligible for a Casitas rebate following purchase and installation. It is not required that all recommendations be implemented to pursue a rebate with Casitas. Applicants must complete survey in 60 Days or lose their place in line for funding.
- There is a limit of one rebate per customer.
- A receipt for all purchased equipment must be provided to Casitas and they shall be specifically identified in the initial VCRCD Agricultural Irrigation Evaluation. Applicants need to complete their purchases within 60 days or lose their place in the funding line. There will be no rebate for labor cost, taxes or fees. **Total rebate amount will not exceed 50% of the receipt amount or \$400. Rebates will be provided on a first come first served basis until all designated funds are expended.**
- Submit a copy of the VCRCD survey identifying the equipment and actions recommended and implemented to Casitas with your application.
- The rebate program is not responsible for materials lost by mail.
- Participants must agree to a post-installation inspection to verify implementation per the VCRCD Irrigation Evaluation recommendations and proper operation, upon request.
- Rebates may take 8 to 16 weeks to process.

**Instructions:**

- To start the process, contact the VCRCDD to schedule and then complete an irrigation evaluation.

- Purchase and install equipment according to manufacturer's specifications within 60 days of receiving recommendations from VCRCDD. Professional installation is recommended but not required

**Privacy Notice:**
