Julia Aranda provided a presentation on the project including funding opportunities in the amount of \$21.3 million dollars for a total project cost of \$20-24 Million. The state board has asked if we need more money which we may be able to get through the ASADRA program. The board discussed the project with Director Brennan suggesting that he had heard that NEPA is taking twice as long as expected.

Public comments were made by Scott Vanderkar who manages family property on the west side of Casitas Pass. In discussions with neighbors who may be impacted by this project there is little objection that he has heard except for one comment regarding compensation for land. The majority of the drilling and pipeline will be snaking underground and is not disturbing the surface. He expressed concern on the cost of water and that the Rincon fault crosses in that area. Julia responded that we have done extensive geo tech and have recommendations on addressing that and the horizontal directional drilling will be 100 feet deep at some points. President Hajas thanked him for his support adding that the Rincon area may be the greatest beneficiary of this project.
